

**HARPER'S CHOICE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION
BOARD MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 7, 2010

The Board of Directors of the Harper's Choice Community Association conducted its regular meeting on Tuesday September 7, 2010 at Kahler Hall, Columbia, Maryland. Evan Rose, Clare Brooks, JD Smith, Alicia Kong, Ann DeLacy, Kevin Preston and Wendy Tzucker were in attendance.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Mr. Smith moved to approve the Agenda as amended with the addition of signage and newsletter. Ms. Brooks seconded: all in favor

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Signage – John Slater and Denis Ellis presented drawing of a proposed sign for the Village entry on Harper's Farm Rd. The sign committee had suggested to Mr. Slater that the new logo for Harper's Choice reflect that fact that after serving bravely in the cavalry during the Revolutionary War Goodloe Harper had made a "Choice" to select this portion of the Carroll estate as his home. The new logo and sign will reflect that historical fact. After discussion, **Ms. DeLacy moved to select the horse with the cross swords without the surrounding box. Mr. Preston seconded: all in favor.**

Longfellow Tot Lot – Mr. Ellis presented plans for refurbishing the tot lot near the pool and basketball courts. He pointed out that the new equipment will be similar to the equipment already there, but will have one less swing to ensure safety. **Mr. Preston moved to approve the tot lot plans as presented. Mr. Smith seconded: all in favor.**

Donation to the Bob Russell Fund at the Columbia Foundation - Ms. Tzucker presented a synopsis of the work in, and for the community that Mr. Russell had accomplished in the past 30+ years. **Mr. Preston moved that a \$500 donation be made to the Bob Russell fund at the Columbia Foundation. Ms. DeLacy seconded: all in favor.**

Newsletter – Mr. Preston reported that he had spoken to a resident regarding her concerns with the newsletter. Mr. Preston and Mr. Smith volunteered to review the newsletter prior to the next publication.
